average of 1800 orphans and vulnerable children in the Lunga Lunga Sub-County. KidsCare team thanks all the County government ministers and other officials for their cooperation to make a better future for the children. In July already 180 households in 12 villages are participating in this homecare and beekeepers program.

Modern KidsCare Farm

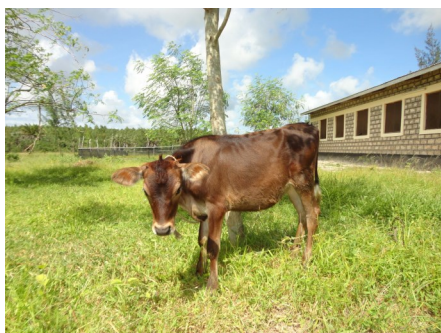

KidsCare is a wonderful place to be especially with activities that require such an attractive environment."

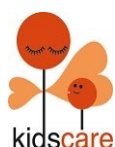
